Prizes: Awarded for first, second and third place in each category and age division.

Requirements: All baked items--must contain 100% pure maple syrup as an ingredient. Each entry must be exhibited on a disposable display and recipe on **FRONT SIDES ONLY** of a 3 x 5 card.

Judging: Will be closed. Winners will be announced before the parade. Each item will be judged on appearance, texture, flavor and overall display.

Display: Baked goods will remain on display after the parade until 2:00 pm. Entries will be discarded after 2:00pm

Helpful Hint: Maple syrup can be substituted for sugar in many recipes. When substituting, use 1½ cups of pure maple syrup for each cup of granulated sugar and add ¼ teaspoon baking soda for each cup of maple syrup used. When maple syrup is substituted for all the sugar in a recipe, reduce the amount of liquid used by one-half. If maple syrup is substituted for half the sugar, reduce the liquid amounts by one-fourth.
